Camp Friday 13 – Monday 16 June

Camp will again be held at Pontispool near Taunton. Starting with your evening meal on the Friday, lessons in flatwork, show jumping and cross country (all optional) on Saturday, Sunday and Monday morning, finishing after lunch on Monday. A talk on feeds and a quiz are also lined up.

Camp is £220 per person which includes basic portacabin accommodation and food for you, accommodation, hay and straw for your horse. In addition to the £220, we again have the 3 en-suite rooms available at £45 single, £35 double/twin per person per night (£135 single or £105 for the 3 nights per person). I have also booked the Longbarn (www.somersetlongbarn.co.uk) which can accommodate up to 12 people in twin rooms.

The Longbarn has an indoor pool, hot tub etc and is the height of luxury, however it doesn't come cheap and is an additional £167 per person to the cost of camp. The luxury facilities are only available to those staying in the Longbarn. The Longbarn and en-suite rooms are payable in full at the time of booking in addition to the deposit for camp itself. Sadly if you cannot attend it is up to the individual to find a replacement and recoup their money for the additional accommodation.

All bookings are strictly first come first served, your place will only be reserved on receipt of a deposit of £75 for camp and payment in full for any additional accommodation. Deposits will be returned if cancelled up to one month prior to camp, after this they will only be returned if a replacement can be found.
